#### CONTEST RULES

##### THEME: TRANSIT BUILDS COMMUNITY

- Students are encouraged to be creative in how they interpret the theme: Transit Builds Community. But GTrans would like you to keep these questions in mind:
  - How is GTrans connecting our community?
  - How do the GTrans buses allow our community to grow?
  - How do people interact with GTrans? (Operators, Bus Stops, Passengers)
  - The GTrans logo must appear on any drawings of buses or bus stops.

##### ELIGIBILITY:

- The Art Contest is open to all students in high school and college attending public, charter, or private schools.

##### CONTEST DETAILS:

- Posters are due on **Friday, March 27, 2020.**
- Entries may be mailed or dropped off at the GTrans at 13999 South Western Ave., Gardena, CA 90249.**
- All entries should be accompanied by a **completed entry form attached to the poster.** GTrans is not responsible for entry forms that become unattached. **As a precaution, legibly print or affix a label with the student's name, school, grade and category on the back of the entry.**

- Art must be single-sided on 12x18-in. or larger.
- Judges will select 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners for award certificates and prizes.
- Art should feature elements of GTrans' service and prominently reflect this year's theme: **"Transit Builds Community"**.
- One entry and one category per student.
- The entry should be an original work completed in its entirety by the student.
- All submitted entries become the property of GTrans and will not be returned.
- All contest entry designs become the property of GTrans and may be used for promotional purposes, marketing, or any other purposes.
- GTrans reserves the right to refuse any entry that does not meet eligibility criteria or theme content.
