Study Overview

The **PATH (Planning a Transit Horizon) Project** represents the GTrans' commitment to shaping the future of local and regional mobility. The study focuses on creating a transit system that is more connected, efficient, and inclusive for everyone who lives, works, and travels throughout the region.

Through this effort, GTrans is evaluating ways to improve access to jobs, schools, and key destinations; strengthen connection with nearby transit systems; and prepare for future growth and major regional events such as the 2026 FIFA World Cup, 2027 Super Bowl, and 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The goal of The PATH Project is to build a modern, sustainable, and community-driven transit network that enhances mobility and quality of life well into the future.

Study Objectives



Analyze post-pandemic travel trends to understand current mobility patterns locally and within the region.



Enhance GTrans Service connections by evaluating how routes and schedules can complement neighboring cities and transit providers.



Expand mobility for all by ensuring improvements meet the needs of transit-dependent, riders and underserved communities.



Advance sustainability through a system that encourages ridership and supports a cleaner environment.



Focus on efficiency and safety to deliver more reliable service for riders and operators.

What the Study Includes

The study will examine both GTrans fixed-route bus services and microtransit operations, reviewing how these services can provide more reliable, flexible, and accessible travel options, while considering opportunities to align with boarder regional mobility plans.
